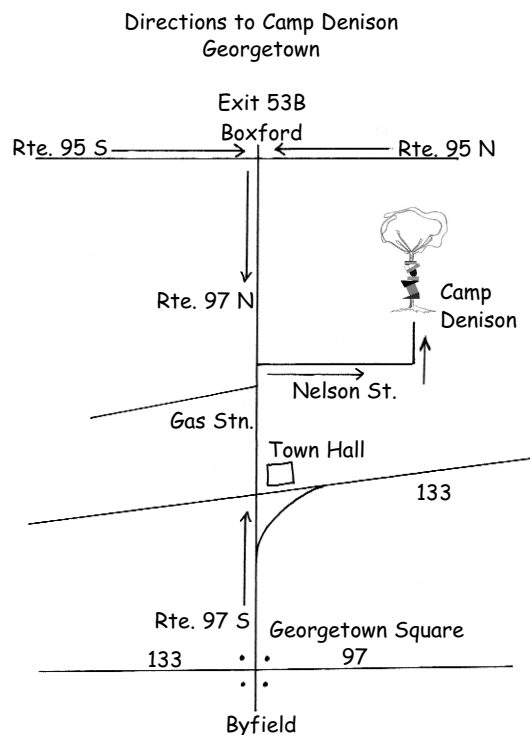
### About Camp Denison

Camp Denison is a 36-acre, wooded retreat and Grand Lodge nestled on the edge of Georgetown and Boxford, along the Baldpate Pond. Built in the early 1930's for inner-city dwellers to escape to the country for recreation and renewal, it had fallen into disrepair. The Friends of Camp Denison Committee, with the leadership of Bob Morehouse and in partnership with the Georgetown Conservation Commission, have devoted hundreds of volunteer hours to beautifully restore the site. Now it is a hidden jewel ready to once again welcome visitors to pristine vistas, wilderness hiking trails and its historic lodge.





 **ART:** This workshop will focus on painting, drawing, print-making and sculpting. These areas of art can be explored on canvas, paper, fabric, wood, clay, wire and metals.

 **PERFORMANCE:** This workshop celebrates song, theater, dance, puppets, and music with the goal of an ensemble presentation as the final event each session.

 **CRAFT:** This workshop teaches design and how to use tools to create useful items, developing skills for practical uses and creative expression.

 **NATURE:** This workshop will introduce ecosystems, shelters, plant identification, animal observation, geology and an appreciation for unspoiled nature through hikes, art projects, journal-keeping, folklore and games.

 **COMMUNITY:** This workshop supports the daily routines of the program's community. It also hosts team sports, group challenges, scavenger hunts and games. The goal is to promote unity. A Camp Denison restoration and beatification project will be one of the activities for community workshop.

 **AIT: Artist in Training Program:** An internship for grades 7-9 to work directly with Workshop Specialists. The AIT program includes: organizational skills, helping younger campers, craftsmanship, & safety. AIT's have an opportunity to work on individual projects and meet as a group.
