-  **ART:** This workshop will focus on painting, drawing, print-making and sculpting. These areas of art can be explored on canvas, paper, fabric, wood, clay, wire and metals.
-  **PERFORMANCE:** This workshop celebrates song, theater, dance, puppets, and music with the goal of an ensemble presentation as the final event each session.
-  **CRAFT:** This workshop teaches design and how to use tools to create useful items, developing skills for practical uses and creative expression.
-  **NATURE:** This workshop will introduce ecosystems, shelters, plant identification, animal observation, geology and an appreciation for unspoiled nature through hikes, art projects, journal-keeping, folklore and games.
-  **COMMUNITY:** This workshop supports the daily routines of the program's community. It also hosts team sports, group challenges, scavenger hunts and games. The goal is to promote unity. A Camp Denison restoration and beautification project will be one of the activities for community workshop.
-  **AIT: Artist in Training Program:** An internship for grades 7-9 to work directly with Workshop Specialists. The AIT program includes: organizational skills, helping younger campers, craftsmanship, & safety. AIT's have an opportunity to work on individual projects and meet as a group.
